As a Beta Tester, we'll rely on you to rigorously test the software and report and problems (bugs) you might find. In addition, we are also very interested in any suggestions you might have for improving the environment or the documentation.

Testing Club Caribe should be fun, but it is **VERY IMPORTANT** to report any problems or inconsistencies that you see as soon as you find them. The message board for reporting bugs is located in the Club Caribe Test Station. Please read the text files on the "Bug Reporting" menu BEFORE you post your bugs.

Club Caribe and the Club Caribe Test Station will both be non-Plus areas, although Club Caribe will be a Plus service when it is launched. We ask that you do not abuse the privilege of non-Plus access to these areas. Also, please remember that you have signed a non-disclosure agreement. Any information you have on Club Caribe and the Beta test is confidential and should not be discussed with anyone who is not involved in the Beta test.

We have worked for many months to build Club Caribe, using tools developed by Lucasfilm Ltd., to create a vacation environment that is fun-filled and exciting. We hope you will agree that Club Caribe will make an excellent addition to Q-Link.
